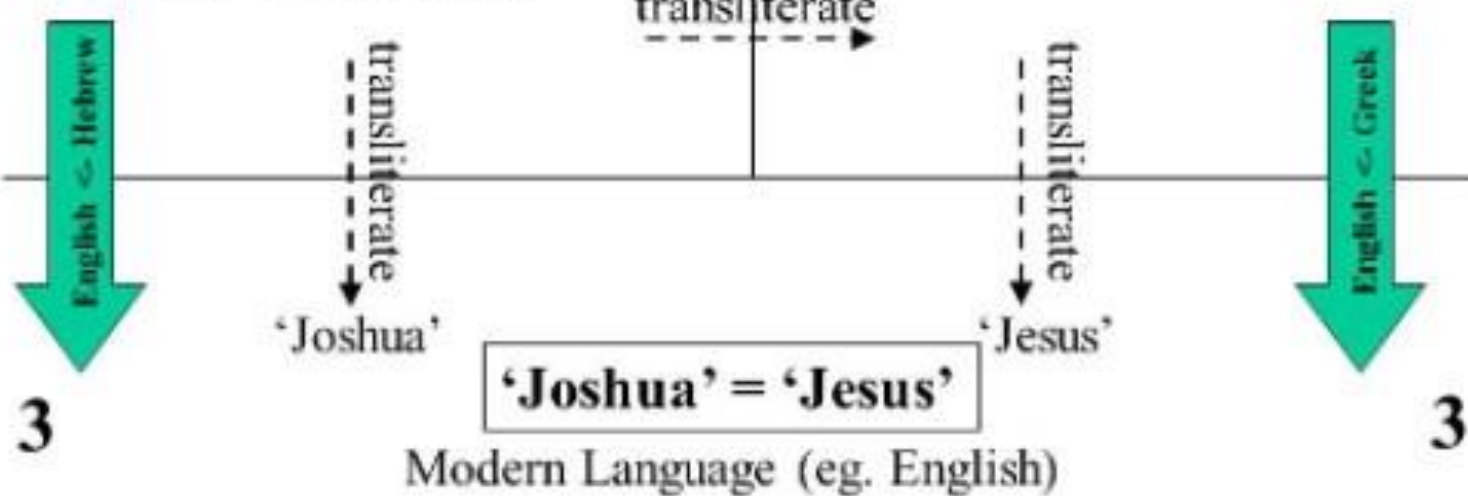

from 3068 and 3457; *Jehovah-saved*;
Jehoshuâ (i.e. Joshua), the Jewish leader:—*Jehoshua*,

2424. Ἰησοῦς **Iēsōus**, *ee-ay-sooce'*; of Heb. or
[3091]; *Jesus* (i.e. *Jehoshua*), the name of our Lord
