

- Basic Lesson: Will we ultimately "cave in" (due to debilitating times of discouragement) and forsake God's direction of His Way of Life?




What Is A Parable?

- A Parable is <u>not</u> a straightforward description of an event, just as it occurred or will occur.
- A Parable is intended to be <u>similar</u> to a real event or a comparison that has to be <u>interpreted</u> to reveal the true meaning.


- Contrasting the faithfulness of our loving God to the cynical, self-serving and unrighteous judge.
- God is always willing to hear our prayers and answer them, within His will.
- God will vindicate His people.



- -Verse 7 "... though he bear long with them?"
- The "them" appears to refer to the oppressors of His elect.
- The meaning is, that although He tolerates these oppressions for a long time, He will at length interpose, in behalf of His own elect.



- Verse 8 "I tell you that He will avenge them speedily..."
- Probable better rendering is "suddenly" or "unexpectedly". When God's tolerance of these oppressors has run its course, He will promptly act at the right time to deliver His people.




- Verse 8 "Nevertheless, when the Son of man comes, will He really find faith on the earth?"
- The implication seems to be that very few will have the strength of faith that Jesus is talking about.



- Verse 8 "Nevertheless, when the Son of man comes, will He really find faith on the earth?"
- Do we have this faith?
- Is there evidence of this faith?
- -Are we continuing to pray and not lose heart?
- Will we fail? Will keep the faith until the end?

What can cause a Disciple of Jesus Christ to break?

-Luke 14:25-33

- The Greek word translated into the English word, Disciple, is mathētēs; Strongs Concordance #3101 / Used 269 times / Translated as Disciple.
 - Vines Expository Dictionary defines it as lit., "a learner" (from manthano, "to learn," from a root math--, indicating thought accompanied by endeavor)



Follower or Disciple?

Key Concept: Difference Between Follower or Disciple

- The Greek word translated into the English word, Disciple carries the idea / context of someone who is not only learning and following, but someone who wants to emulate another.
- When Jesus taught, there were thousands of people that enjoyed His teaching. Many followed Him from place to place, but there were only a few who became disciples.
 - Matthew 28:19-20, "As you are going, make disciples among all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit, teaching them to obey and practice all that I have commanded you, and remember, I will be right there with you every step of the way."

Will Jesus Christ Find Living Faith?

John 15:1-11

- With Living Faith, our belief galvanizes into a conviction that will produce righteous works.

II Corinthians 13:5

- Test ourselves to prove that Christ lives in us.
