

-Caution against assuming opponents are human or that the battle can be fought with human resources.





Lust for Forbidden Pleasures


- I John 2:15-17

Satan's Four D's

Among Other Devices Satan Uses

- <u>Disappointment</u>: We look at people as our standard, we can be disappointed.
- <u>Discouragement</u>: Dwelling on disappointments leads to discouragement.
- <u>Doubt</u>: Discouragement left unchecked leads to doubt.
- Division: Doubts and worries can lead to division of our loyalties. This can lead to divisions between people and distancing from God.

The Purposes of the Gifts

- <u>I Corinthians 12:7</u> "To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good."
- <u>I Kings 3:9-10</u> "Therefore give to Your servant an understanding heart to judge Your people, that I may discern between good and evil. For who is able to judge this great people of Yours?"
- <u>Ezekiel 44:23-24</u> Discernment to make distinctions between holy and profane.

Discernment an Imperative

- <u>I John 4:1</u> "...believe not every spirit..."
- <u>I Thessalonians 5:21-22</u> "But examine everything carefully; hold fast to that which is good; abstain from every form of evil."
- <u>John 17:17</u> "Sanctify them in the truth; Your word is truth."

Is the Holy Spirit Working "With" or "In" Us?

- John 14:15-18

 The Holy Spirit may be "with us" leading to Jesus Christ, but it is not "in us" until we respond and being meeting the conditions.



Is the Holy Spirit Working "With" or "In" Us?

- I Corinthians 2:10-16
 - Reading the Word of God, with the Holy Spirit enables to know the "things of God" and make right judgments.



Exercise in Discernment

- Hebrews 5:12-14
 - "One of the best ways to discern the nature of a spirit is to check the Word of God. Does what the spirit says match up with the Word of God?"
