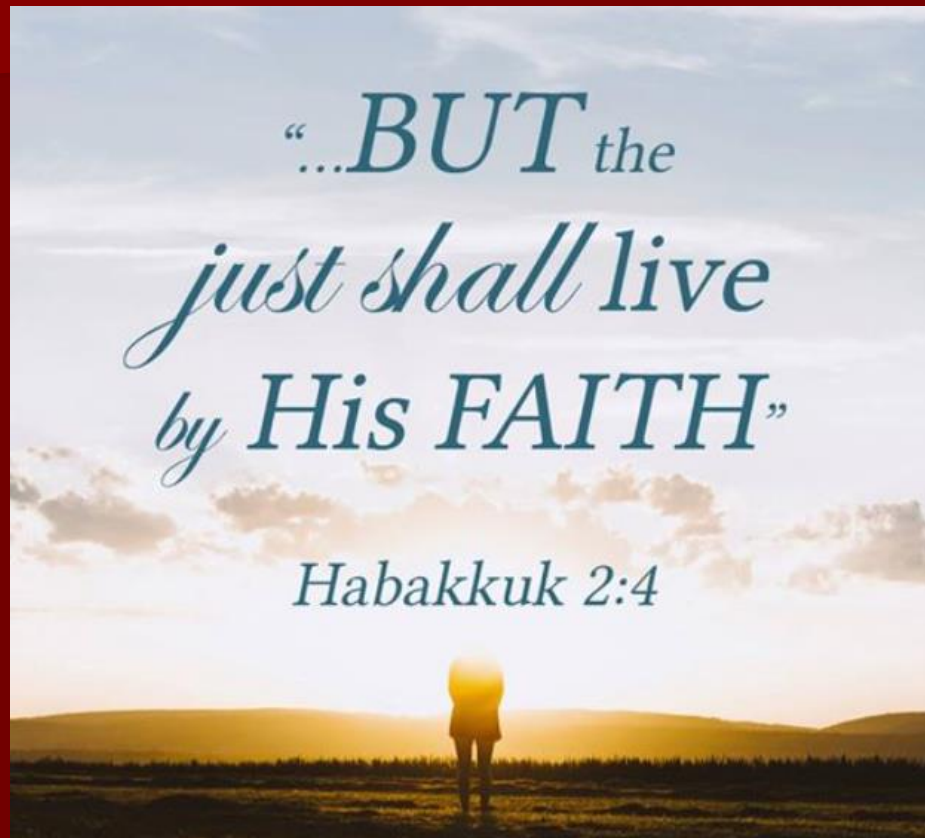

Live By His Faith

■ Habakkuk 2:4

- **“...the proud one...”** - Collective for the Babylonians and with special reference to their king.
- **“...the righteous (just) will live by His Faith.”** - In light of God’s revelation about how and when He is working, His people are to wait patiently and live by His faith; trusting in their sovereign God.
 - This clause is quoted frequently in the New Testament.

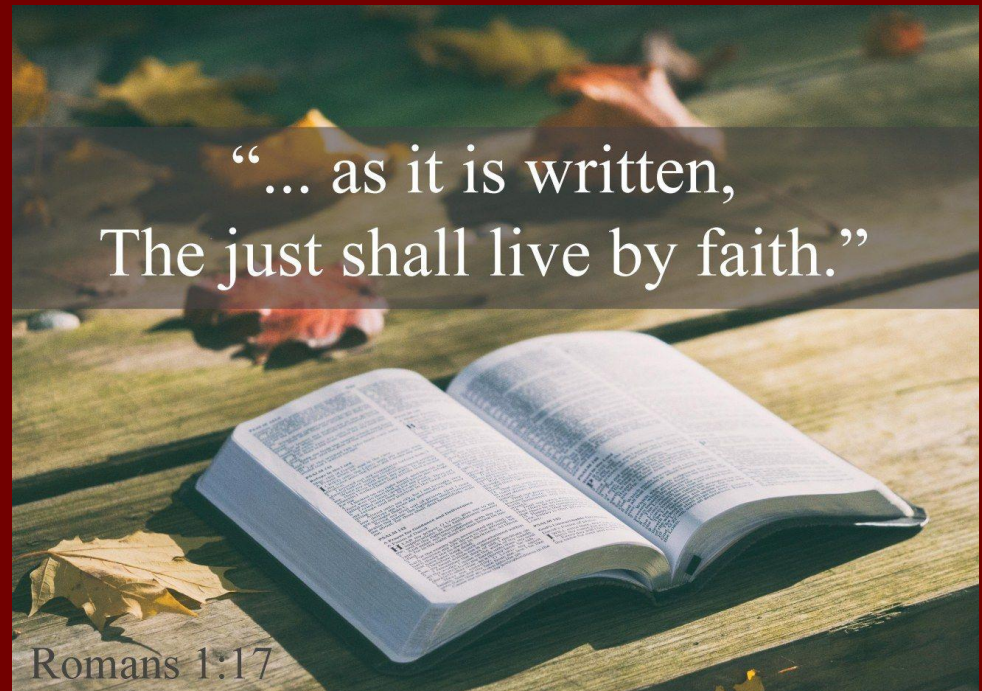
Live By His Faith

■ Habakkuk

- The name means to “embrace” or “wrestle”.
 - Embracing and Wrestling with difficult issues
 - Good and Evil in the world
 - Why does evil seem to prosper, in this world?
 - What is God doing in this world?
- Asking us,
 - Which side are you on?
 - Will count you among the proud, who will be destroyed or the just, the faithful, who will be rewarded?
 - Choose your side

Live By His Faith

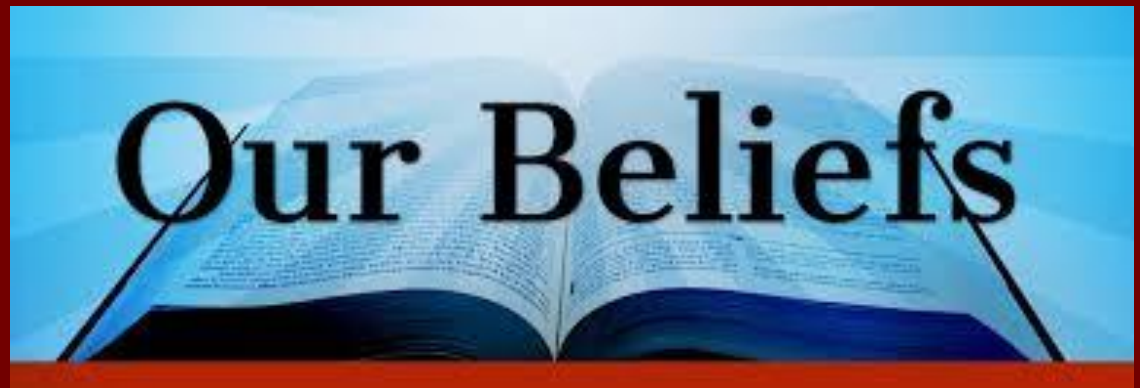

■ Deuteronomy 4:5-7

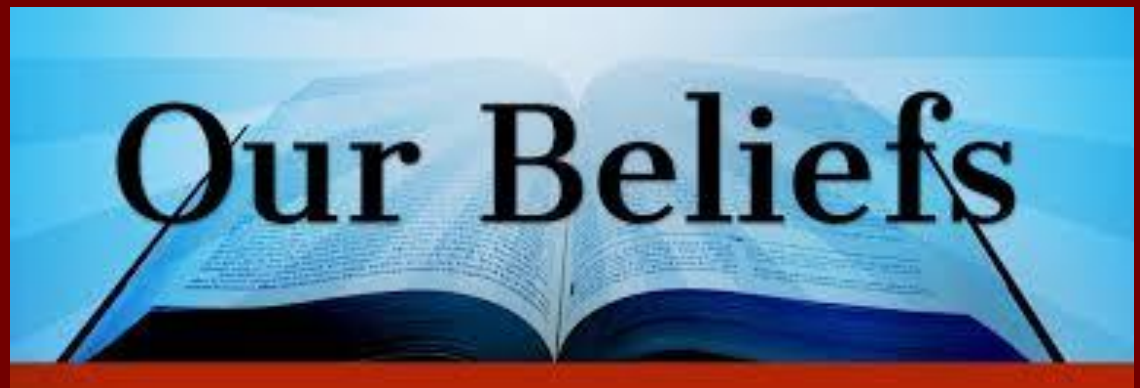
- God's statutes, judgments and commandments
- This is our wisdom and understanding
- Draws us near to God
- These are righteous



Live By His Faith

■ Psalm 119:4-7

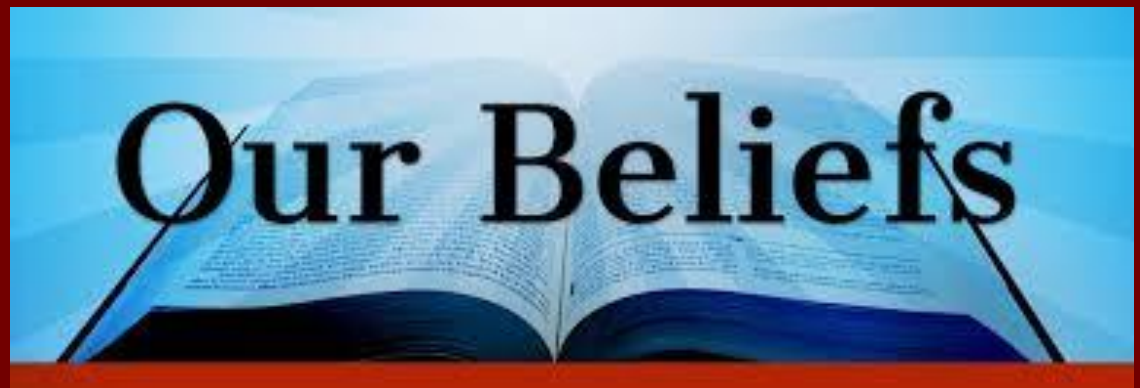
- God's precepts are ordained or commanded
- We are to be diligent in keeping them
- Removes shame or guilty from us
- We must learn righteousness; it must be acquired



Live By His Faith

■ Psalm 119:169-176

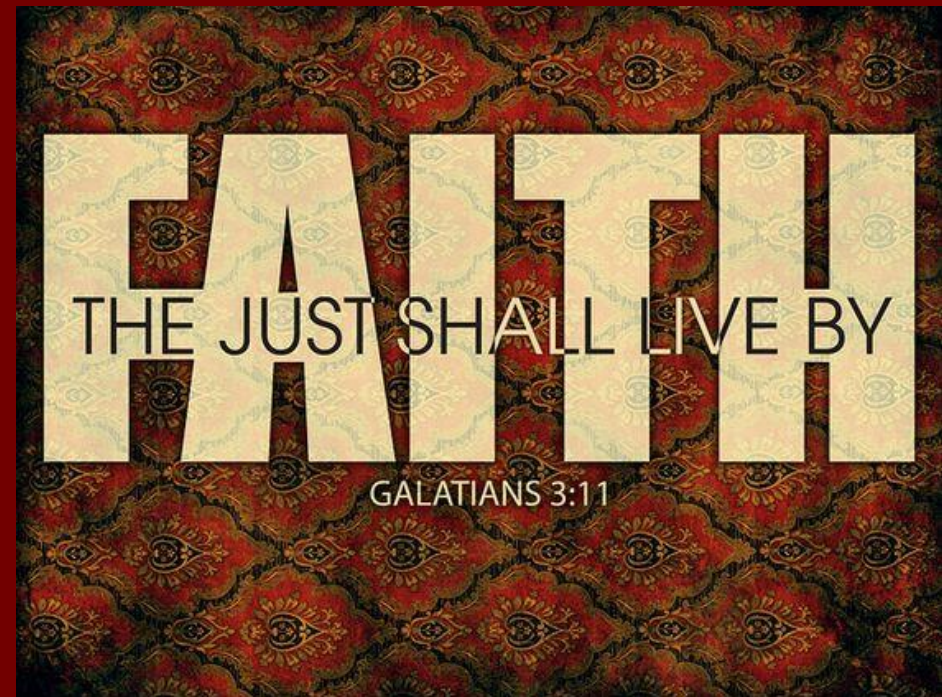
- God give us understanding of His Words
- God's Word (utterance, speech, word / i.e. Word of God, the Torah) provide the way to deliverance (confusion, deception, sin)
- God's Words should be a delight to us



Live By His Faith


■ **Galatians 3:10-14** "...No one is justified by the Law before God is evident; for, "The righteous man shall live by faith"the Law is not based upon faith..."He who practices them shall live in them..."

– **Romans 10:4-5**
"...For Moses writes that the man who practices the righteousness which is based on Law shall live by that righteousness."



Live By His Faith

- **Hebrews 10:36-39** "...For you have need of endurance, so that when you have done the will of God, you may receive what was promised....but my righteous one shall live by faith and if he shrinks back, my soul has no pleasure in him"
