Three Main Harvests / Three Annual Pilgrimages

- **The Year's 3 Main Harvests Were Completed / Crops Were Sold / Enabled To Attend God's Feasts**
- **Many came to Jerusalem and stayed more than 3 weeks arriving before the Feast of Trumpets**
- **Example of Nehemiah 8:1-12**



Utilization of Trumpets

- **Signify a call to war**
- **Summon soldiers**
- **Sound in times of danger**
- **Signify time markers**
(months, Holy Days, Year of Jubilee)
- **Music, hymns and praise to God**
- **Religious Services**



Utilization of Trumpets

■ Religious Services

- Bring up of the Ark of the Covenant
- Anointing of Kings
- Dedication of the Temple's (Temple Construction)



Yom Teruah

- ***Yom Teruah*** – “day of shouting/blasting”
 - **Leviticus 23:24-25** “Speak to the sons of Israel, saying, `In the seventh month on the first of the month you shall have a rest, a reminder by blowing {of trumpets}, a holy convocation. `You shall not do any laborious work, but you shall present an offering by fire to the LORD”
 - **Numbers 29:1-6** “Now in the seventh month, on the first *day* of the month, you shall have a holy assembly; you shall do no laborious work. It will be to you a day for blowing trumpets. And you shall offer a burnt offering as a soothing aroma to the LORD: one bull, one ram, *and* seven male lambs one year old without defect...”

Old & New Testament Connections

- ***Tishri*** – “Beginning” / ***Rosh HaShanah*** – “Head of the Year” / ***Rosh Chodesh*** – “New Moon” / ***Ethanim*** – “Strong” or “Valiant”
 - Reference to the return and intervention of the supremely strong and valiant Captain of our Salvation, Jesus Christ.
 - **Hebrews 2:10** “For it became Him, for whom are all things and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings.”

Old & New Testament Connections

■ Yom Hakeseh / The Hidden Day

- It is the only Holy Day of God that is kept on the new moon (1st day of a month).
- In Ancient Israel the sighting / determination of the new moon could be a challenge and unpredictable (leading to some making the Feast a 2 day event).
- Mark 13:32 “No one knows about that day or hour, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father.”

New Testament Connections

- **Return of Jesus Christ / Resurrection of the Dead**
 - “And He shall send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they will gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.” (Matthew 24:31)
 - “. . . in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.” (I Corinthians 15:52)

Judgment, Resurrection, Hope and Faith in Trumpets

- **Return of Jesus Christ / Resurrection of the Dead**
 - “...For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God” ([I Thessalonians 4:16](#))
 - “Then the seventh angel sounded: And there were loud voices in heaven, saying, “The kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our Lord and of His Christ, and He shall reign forever and ever!”” ([Revelation 11:15](#))

4th



1/3 of sun, moon, and stars do not shine.

Rev. 8:12

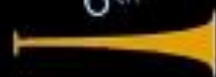
5th



"Locusts" wield the Beast's military power.
