■ Genesis 5:21-24

Walking With God

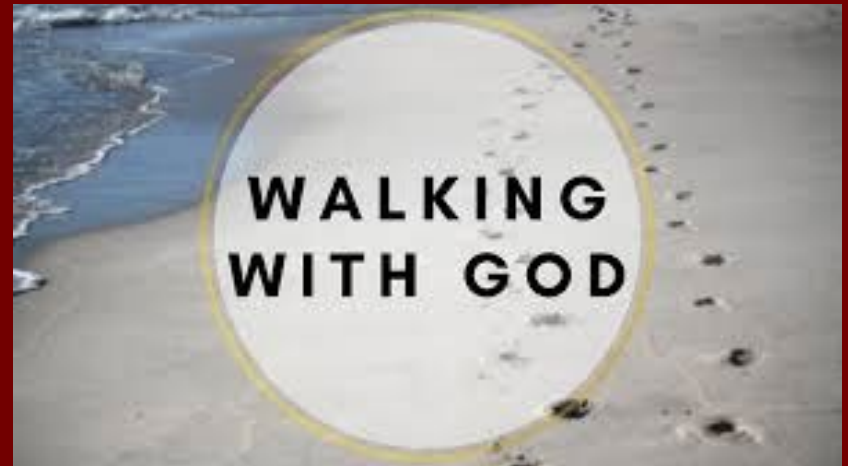
■ Hebrews 11:5
