
- God makes a great promise to Jeroboam

Matthew 24:23-27 — "...false Christs and false prophets will arise ...will show great signs and wonders"

II Thessalonians 2:9-10 — "...coming is in accord with Satan, with all power and signs and false wonders..."

I Corinthians 10:11 – "...happened to them as an example ...written for our instruction..."

Revelation 13:1-18 — "...the dragon gave him power, his throne and his authority..."
