“... Do this in Remembrance of Me...”

■ I Corinthians 11:23-26

- During the Passover Season we remember what Jesus did for all**
- During the Passover Season we proclaim the Lord's death, until He comes.**

Jesus: The Christ/ The Messiah/ The Lamb of God

■ John 1:29-41

- The Christ (Greek – *Christos*) – The Messiah (Hebrew – *Maw-Shakh*)**
- The Lamb of God – The Passover Lamb (I Corinthians 5:7; Exodus 12:1-13; I Peter 1:19)**

Jesus: The Lord of All / The Judge of the Living and Dead

■ Acts 10:34-43

- The Christ is the Anointed One; He is The Way, the only Way, to Salvation**
- Anointed – “Chrlo” – to smear or rub with oil. To consecrate to an office or religious service
(Exodus 30:22-31)**

Jesus: Anointed to Preach / Proclaim Release

■ Luke 4:16-21

- Jesus' custom of regular worship sets an example for all His followers.**
- God the Father anointed Jesus Christ with the Holy Spirit for the purposes of preaching and healing**
- Isaiah 61:1-3 Favorable Year of the Lord / Proclaim Salvation**

Jesus The Redeemer

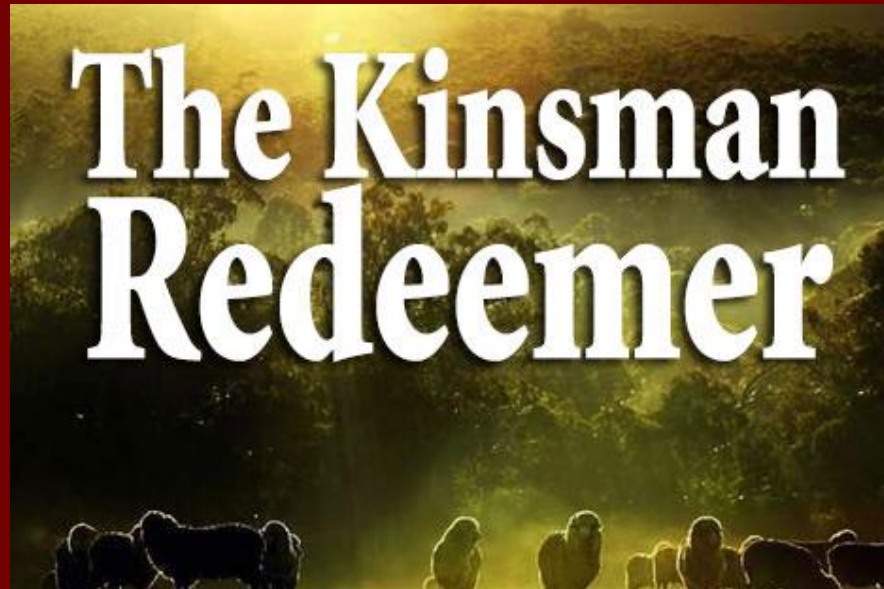
■ Redemption / Propitiation...

➤ **Isaiah 48:17-20**

❖ **Hebrew word for Redeemer is "gaal"**

➤ **To Be The Next Of Kin**

➤ **i.e. Avenger, Deliver, Kinsfolk, Ransom**



Jesus The Justifier

- **Justifier** – A person who argues to defend or justify some policy or institution. One who justifies; one who vindicates, supports defends or absolves

JUSTIFIED

means

"just-as-if-I'd
never sinned"

Jesus The Justifier

■ Romans 3:21-31; 4:1-8

- God declares the person to be not guilty / cancels the guilt.
- God declares the person to be righteous / credits righteousness with belief.

Jesus The Reconciler

- **Reconciliation – The restoration of friendly relations**
 - **Colossians 1:20-23**
 - ❖ **Greek word for Reconcile is “apokatalasso” / Compound word**
 - **“apo” - Finishing and Completion**
 - **“katalasso” – The exchange of hostility for a friendly relationship, reconcile.**
 - **Reconcile Fully**

Jesus The High Priest

- **The word “priest” means one who mediates in religious services. It also means one who is holy or set apart to perform those services.**
 - **Hebrews 2:17-18; 4:11-16**
 - ❖ **1st Place the word “priest” is found is Genesis 14:10-24**
 - ❖ **Abram met Melchizedek, King of Salem and priest of the Most High God.**
 - ❖ **Jesus referenced with Melchizedek in Psalm 110, Hebrews 5:6, Hebrews 7:1-3,25-28**

Jesus The Mediator of New Covenant

- **As the High Priest, Jesus the Anointed One, presents us to God the Father**

➤ **Hebrews 9:11-15**

Jesus Christ as the High Priest is a utilization of His Sacrifice for us and all man (upon belief and acceptance of Jesus Christ as their Savior).
