

The Branch

- Is there something more to the Branch than we have realized?
- Is the Branch's identification as Messiah all that the prophets meant to convey?
- Is there anything more about the Messiah that His identification as the Branch can tell us?
- Could it possibly tell us something about ourselves and our tremendous potential as children of God?


What Is a "Branch"?

- "Branch" is capitalized six times in the Old Testament.
 - Hebrew "semah" is used five times
 - "Sprout, Growth or Branch"
 - Hebrew "hoter" is used one time
 - "Branch or Twig"



What Is a "Branch"?

- Branch" is used in terms of a genealogical sense
 - Certain person belongs to or descends from a family line
 - "Heir, Descendant, Seed or Family Tree"



- Isaiah 11:1-5
 - "There shall come forth a Rod from the stem of Jesse, and a Branch (hoter) shall grow out of his roots."
 - Context The Messiah will descend from the line of Jesse, the father of David.



■ Jeremiah 23:1-8

 "...I will raise to David a Branch of righteousness; a King shall reign and prosper and execute judgment and righteousness...THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS."

Jeremiah 33:14-18


- "...I will cause to grow up to David a Branch of righteousness; He shall execute judgment and righteousness in the earth...David shall never lack a man to sit on the throne of the house of Israel. And the Levitical priests shall never lack a man before Me... to prepare sacrifices continually."

- Zechariah 3:8-10
 - "...My Servant the Branch...remove the inquitity of that land in one day"
 - Jesus Christ performed this act

Zechariah 6:11-15

- "...Behold, a man whose name is Branch...He will build the temple of the Lord...He will bear the honor and sit and rule on His throne...He will be a priest on His throne and the counsel of peace will be between the two offices."



■ Isaiah 4:1-6

- "...the Branch of the Lord."
- He is God's descendant.
- He is the Son of God, not just the son of the man David
- "...the fruit of the earth."
- Though, He is God, His is also from mankind.
- He could claim full descent from both the Godkind and humankind.




Jesus Christ the "Dayspring" / "Sunrise"
