Matthew 7:21-23

- * "Lord, Lord..."
 - Kyrios / G2962 / divine title, which is used in the Septuagint for 'Jehovah'
 - "having power" (*kuros*) or "authority," translated in the NT, "'Lord,' 'master,' 'Master,' 'owner,' 'Sir,' a title of wide significance, occurring in most books of the NT

 Have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name? Surely, Jesus should know them. But Jesus will say to them, 'I never knew you.'



Jesus' teaching is about faith. We are saved by faith. And faith, everywhere in the Bible, means obedience to God. It means to do His will.

- Unless we have faith, we will not obey God
- Faith motives us to listen to Him
- Faith enables us to realize that Jesus is the judge who is to come and who shall reign over the earth
- ***** Faith enables us to see our sinfulness
- Faith enables us to understand that no one can save us from sin and from the judgment, except Jesus Christ
