Where is the Kingdom of God?

- Answer: Currently, Heaven
 - ➤ Isaiah 66:1- Thus says the Lord:

 "Heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool; what is the house that you would build for me, and what is the place of my rest?



Where is the Kingdom of God?

- Answer: Currently, Heaven
 - Therefore hear the word of the LORD: I saw the LORD sitting on his throne, and all the host of heaven standing on his right hand and on his left.
 - **Psalm 11:4** The Lord is in his holy temple; the Lord's throne is in heaven; his eyes see, his eyelids test the children of man.

Where is the Kingdom of God?

- Answer: Currently, Heaven
 - ► Hebrews 8:1- Now the point in what we are saying is this: we have such a high priest, uone who is seated at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in heaven,
 - ➤ Hebrews 12:2 looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.

- God's throne is a place of power and authority.
 - In <u>2 Chronicles 18:18</u>, the prophet Micaiah relates his vision of God's throne room, in which spirit beings stand in attendance.
 - In <u>Job 1:6</u>, where God demands answers from the angelic beings summoned there.

- God's throne is a place of majesty and honor.
 - The Bible says that, when Jesus ascended to heaven, He "sat down at the right hand of the throne of God" (<u>Hebrews 12:2</u>).
 - There is no higher place than heaven. God is the King of heaven, and Jesus holds the place of honor at <u>God's right hand</u>.

- God's throne is a place of perfect justice.
 - "He has prepared His throne for judgment" (Psalm 9:7; cf. 89:14).
 - The final judgment, described in <u>Revelation 21</u>, is held before "a <u>great white throne</u>" (verse 11).

- God's throne is a place of purity.
 - Only the redeemed, those who have been granted the righteousness of Christ, will have the right to stand before His throne (<u>Revelation 14:5</u>).

- God's throne is a place of eternal life.
 - God is the Source of life. In heaven, John sees "the river of the water of life, as clear as crystal, flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb" (<u>Revelation 22:1</u>).

 - Matthew 4:23; Luke 8:1
- "The Kingdom of Heaven"
 - Matthew 4:17; Matthew 5:3, 10, 19-20

Summary of the Kingdom Parables


Parable of the	Implications of the Parable

Hidden Treasure	Give all that you have to gain the kingdom
Costly Pearl	Sacrifice for the kingdom
Dragnet	The kingdom is only for the righteous


