

- They follow the Lamb wherever He goes
- They are redeemed from mankind
- They are brought out from those that received the mark of the beast
- They have no guile / deceit
- They sing a new song / no one could learn the song, but them.

144,000 / First Fruits Description

Learn (G3129; manthano): to learn, be apprised

- "To increase one's knowledge, to be increased in knowledge"
- "To hear, be informed"
- "To learn by use and practice"
