




- God's view of Righteousness
  - **♦ Isaiah 64:4-7**
    - Do we perceive God's cues?
    - > Listen and Look for God's direction
    - God recognizes Righteous and Unrighteous actions
    - > There are consequences for our actions.

- What is Godly Righteousness?
- Deuteronomy 6:24-25
- What does God require of us?
- Deuteronomy 10:12-22
  - > Fear / Reverence the Lord
  - Walk / Live in all His Ways
  - > Love Him
  - Serve Him with all our heart and soul

- Our Righteousness must be geniune
  - \* Matthew 5:18-20
    - Hollow External Observance; Not Internalized
  - \* Matthew 23:23
    - > "...and have neglected the weightier provisions of the law; justice and mercy and faithfulness; but these are things you should have done, without neglecting the others."

- Belief / Faith without Works is dead
  - **\*James 2:14-26**

- Be Righteous With Godly Righteousness

  - **♦ Psalm 24:3-6**

#### ❖ I Corinthians 2:12-16

12Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, so that we may know the things freely given to us by God, 13which things we also speak, not in words taught by human wisdom, but in those taught by the Spirit, combining spiritual thoughts with spiritual words. 14 But a natural man does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually appraised. 15 But he who is spiritual appraises all things, yet he himself is appraised by no one. 16 For WHO HAS KNOWN THE MIND OF THE LORD, THAT HE WILL INSTRUCT HIM? But we have the mind of Christ.
