- However, other offerings, required to be given on special occasions, played significant roles in broadening our understanding of God and specific parts of God's Plan.

# Wave Sheaf Offering:

Occurring on only one day each year, it is far from minor or obscure in its meaning to salvation. In fact, we could say that, "without what it means to our salvation, there would be no salvation"!



## **Wave the Sheaf Before the LORD**

#### Leviticus 23:9-21

- Wave Sheaf consisted of an omer of barley, still on the stalk, cut at the beginning of the spring harvest.
- Initially, each Israelite possessing a harvest was required to give an offering.
- The priest would wave the offering before the God for acceptance.
- One official waving of a sheaf by a priest in Jerusalem represented all brought by individuals.
- The Wave Sheaf offering represented a thankful acknowledgement to God, as Giver of the harvest, while dedicating or consecrating it to Him.

## **Wave the Sheaf Before the LORD**

#### **■ Leviticus 23:9-21**

- The priests began to make the first cutting right at the end of the Sabbath, continuing over into the first day of the week, when the bulk of the work would be done.
- The offering was not complete until the first sheaf of barley had been threshed or crushed by a "threshing sledge" or "threshing board".
- The threshed barley was then presented before God, the next morning, between 9 AM — Noon.

# The Wave Sheaf Offering Spiritual Harvest

#### John 4:35-36

- "There are still four months and then comes the harvest? Behold, I say to you, lift up your eyes and look at the fields, for they are already white for harvest. An he who reaps receives wages and gathers fruit for eternal life, that both he who sows and he who reaps may rejoice together."
- The spiritual harvest is of people to eternal life.

#### Matthew 9:36-38

- "But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd. Then He said to His disciples, The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest."

# The Firstborn Among Many Brethren

- Romans 8:29 "...firstborn among many brethren."
- I Corinthians 15:20-24 "...Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who are asleep...But each in his own order, Christ, the first fruits, after those who are Christ's at His coming..."
- James 1:17-18 "...so that we would be a kind of first fruits among His creatures."
- Revelation 14:4 "These are the ones who were not defiled with women, for they are virgins. These are the ones who follow the Lamb wherever He goes. These were redeemed from among men, being firstfruits to God and to the Lamb."

- Daniel 9:27 "And he will make a firm covenant with the many for one week, but in the middle of the week, he will put a stop to sacrifice and grain offering..."
- John 19:31, 38-42 "...Then the Jews, because it was the day of preparation...(for that Sabbath was a high day)...Now the place where He was crucified there was a garden...since the tomb was nearby, they laid Jesus there."
- Mark 15:42 "Now when evening had come, because it was the Preparation Day, that is, the day before the Sabbath [an annual Sabbath, the first day of Unleavened Bread]"

- Matthew 12:39-40 "...An evil and adulterous generation craves for a sign [attesting miracle] and yet no sign will be given it, but the sign of Jonah, the prophet: for just as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of the sea creature, so will the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth."
- Counting three days and three nights from Jesus' burial in the tomb on Wednesday evening near sunset brings us to Saturday evening near sunset. As the Sabbath was ending, the Father burst the bonds of Christ's death by the power of His Holy Spirit and resurrected Him as very God.

- Matthew 28:1-7 "Now after the Sabbath, as the first day of the week began, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary cam to see the tomb..."
- Luke 24:3 -12 "Then they went in and did not find the body of the Lord Jesus."
- John 20:10-18 "...Stop clinging to Me, for I have not yet ascended to the Father, but go to My brethren and say to them, 'I ascend to My Father and your Father, and My God and your God.' ..."

# I Am The Resurrection and The Life

Acts 2:24, 32; 3:15

The Father resurrected Jesus Christ.

■ John 11:23-26

"...I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies..."

■ John 6:39-40, 44, 54

Jesus Christ is the one who will resurrect us.



#### Jesus Is The First Fruit

- 1. Jesus is the firstborn of Mary (Matthew 1:23-25)
- Jesus is the first-begotten of God the Father (Hebrews 1:6)
- 3. Jesus is the firstborn of every creature (Colossians 1:15)
- 4. Jesus is the first-begotten from the dead (Revelation 1:5)
- 5. Jesus is the first fruits of the resurrected ones (I Corinthians 15:20,23)
- Jesus is the beginning of the creation of God (Revelation 3:14)
- 7. Jesus is the preeminent One (Colossians 1:18)
