
Considering The Christian Passover

Considering The Christian Passover

■ The Separation of Sin

– Micah 3:4

- Then they will cry out to the LORD, But He will not answer them Instead, He will hide His face from them at that time Because they have practiced evil deeds.

– Isaiah 59:2

- But your iniquities have made a separation between you and your God, And your sins have hidden His face from you so that He does not hear.

Considering The Christian Passover

■ The Separation of Sin

– I Corinthians 15:17

- and if Christ has not been raised, your faith is worthless; you are still in your sins.

– Exodus 32:33

- The LORD said to Moses, "Whoever has sinned against Me, I will blot him out of My book."



Considering The Christian Passover

■ Put On Humility

– **John 13:1-15**

Instituted to teach a lesson of humility against who was going to the greatest in the Kingdom of God

– **Colossians 3:12-13** **Unlike “Pride”, humility does not come naturally; it must be “put on” or added to our character.**

Considering The Christian Passover

■ Put On Humility

– James 4:5-6

Spiritual humility is a developed characteristic, because of contact with God and our willingness to cooperate
